



JUNIOR COLLEGE PREFECT POLICY

1. STRUCTURE OF THE PREFECT SELECTION COMMITTEE:

The Prefect Selection Committee will consist of:

- 1.1. The Principal
- 1.2. The Grade 6 and Grade 7 Grade Tutors, however, other Grade Tutors are welcome to join
- 1.3. Teachers who teach the Grade 6 students
- 1.4. Any other interested staff members

2. PROCEDURE

- 2.1. Prefect selection will take place in Term 3.
- 2.2. Students are required to complete the Prefect Application Form
- 2.3. To be considered for Prefect, students must attend the leadership camp/day, the purpose of which is to identify students according to the leadership skills they display
- 2.4. Voting is done by Grade 6 Staff and by Grade 5 – 7 students and the results are compiled on a spreadsheet.
- 2.5. The Principal and staff involved with the Grade 6 Students meet to discuss the final selection of Prefects based on their merit.
- 2.6. Executive Prefects may be identified at this time.
 - If there are no clearly identifiable Executive Prefects (Head Boy, Head Girl, Deputy Head Boy & Deputy Head Girl); the positions may be minimized accordingly
 - For example, the Executive Prefects may be minimized to only two Head Prefects with no Deputies; or one Head Prefect and Two Deputies; or any other combination based on merit.
- 2.7. Executive Prefects must be selected on merit only and may not be selected for the sake of filling the four positions.

3. BRAIDING & SCROLLS

3.1. Head Prefect

- A red and black striped, flat braid and black twist braid around the blazer
- Two bands of the same braid around the cuff of the blazer
- Scroll – Head Prefect / Head Girl / Head Boy

3.2. Deputy Head Prefect

- A red and black striped, flat braid and black twist braid around the blazer
- Two bands of the same braid around the cuff of the blazer
- Scroll – Deputy Head Prefect / Deputy Head Girl / Deputy Head Boy

3.3. Prefect

- Black twisted braid around the blazer
- Scroll – Prefect
