



## CO-CURRICULAR POLICY

### Co-curricular Policy for Provincial Representation at Ashton College

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

The Co-curricular award signifies the student's attainment of Ashton College a co-curricular scroll in a sport that is not part of the college's standard sporting activities.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 2.1. Only Grade 4 to Form 5 students are eligible for consideration to receive the award.
- 2.2. Students may only receive the award once in the Junior College and once in the Senior College for a sport.

#### 3. QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

- 3.1. To qualify, a student must represent their province at an interprovincial tournament or gathering, engaging with athletes from at least two other provinces.
- 3.2. The student must provide an original letter of selection/representation from the province, verifying their participation and achievement.
- 3.3. The Sport Committee will review the documentation and make the final decision regarding the awarding of the co-curricular scroll.
- 3.4. The committee's decision is binding.

#### 4. AWARD PRIVILEGES

Recipients of this esteemed award are entitled to proudly display the official co-curricular scroll on their Ashton College blazer.
